

Procedure to “Join the discussion!”

... and become a member of the “Our Indigenous Network” bulletin board (also found at ournetwork.net/indigenous/discussion):

1. Navigate to www.ournetwork.net/indigenous
2. Click the “JOIN THE DISCUSSION!” button. If you’re already registered, enter your username and password and log in to the discussion board.
3. Note: Once you’re registered, if you want to bookmark “www.ournetwork.net/indigenous/discussion”, then you can skip seeing the landing page.
4. For new users, click “Register” near the top-right corner. Click that you agree to the terms.
5. You will be asked for a username. This is how you will be known on the site. You don’t have to use your real name, but we’re friends on this site. Any person who submits unfriendly comments will be barred from the site.
6. You will be asked for a password, and your timezone. Toronto is UTC-4:00, at least for now while we’re on Daylight Savings Time.
7. (The username is NOT case-sensitive, but the password is.)
8. You need to enter a “Confirmation code” to prove that you’re not a robot.
9. Then you have to wait a few hours, hopefully less than 24 hours, for the board administrator or moderator to approve you as a user.
10. We are looking for volunteers, people who are willing to share the work of moderating this site. If you are interested, please send an email to Dwight Baer, at: dwight@netsavvy.ca
11. Once you get an email saying that your account is activated, you can feel free to log in and Join the discussion!
12. “Our Indigenous Network” is an informal group not associated with any church or other organization.
13. The purpose of “Our Indigenous Network” is to create a forum for people to interact who care about the situation of indigenous people in Canada.
14. By joining this group, you agree to use the website responsibly and caringly.
15. Click the button to join the discussion now!
